

PBF~R's New Tanker

Fire-Rescue has been anxiously awaiting the arrival of their newest piece of apparatus – a 4,000 gallon tanker by Southern Fire Equipment (SFE recently purchased by E-1). The current tanker has served us well these past 22 years, and will be a back-up for Public Works, or sold at auction.

The new tanker has vacuum capability, allowing fill-up from swimming pools, clean lakes, etc. This is a new venture for Palm Bay. This particular model of tanker also loads in half the time of the older one, which allows for a faster fill-up turn-around on fire-ground scenes where there is no immediate access to fire hydrants.

Training with the new tanker will begin May 27, and the tanker will be placed in service soon after.
