LEGISLATIVE MEMORANDUM

RE: Palm Bay Community Charter Schools – Out of Field Waivers

In 1990, the State of Florida agreed in a federal out of court settlement that teachers who serve the English Language Learner (ELL) student population in Florida must have appropriate training. The Multicultural Education and Training Advocacy (META) Consent Decree, called for Language Arts teachers to have or be working toward the Endorsement if they served ESOL students. Understandable instruction and academic achievement are concerns and goals for ELL students in both Federal and State law. The Agreement calls for all teachers to have some ESOL training if they serve ESOL students, depending on which “category” of subjects the teacher is teaching.

For reporting purposes, we are required to list all teachers who are not ESOL certified or endorsed and who are primary language arts teachers. Primary language arts teachers are all the K-5 teachers (except specials, i.e., music, art, et al.) and the reading/language arts teachers of the middle school. At a very minimum, teachers are compliant with the META Consent Decree as long as they take one ESOL course annually. Notwithstanding, they need to be brought to the Board’s attention during the time period wherein they acquire this certification.

Also addressed in this communication are teachers who are out-of-field in content areas. Attached hereto is a summary of all the Out-of-Field teachers for the Patriot Campus K-8 and high school. Each teacher must sign a document wherein they acknowledge they are out-of-field and will work towards becoming in-field. Teachers who are out-of-field in content areas must also be approved individually by the respective governing board chair. Supporting documentation to that effect will be forthcoming. Also attached is a list of all certified personnel at the Patriot Campus.
