

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-47

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLE XX, UTILITIES CODE, CHAPTER 200, UTILITIES CODE, BY ADJUSTING THE RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES FOR THE CITY'S UTILITIES SYSTEM AND SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CITY OF PALM BAY CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Palm Bay Code of Ordinances, Title XX, Utilities Code, Chapter 200, Utilities Code, is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

"Section 200.03 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS REGARDING UTILITIES SERVICES.

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(M) *Change of Occupancy.* When a change of occupancy occurs on premises with Utilities services, notice shall be provided to the City not less than three (3) days prior to the date of change by the outgoing customer. The outgoing customer shall be held responsible for all Utilities services rendered on such premises until notice is received by the City and the City has had reasonable time to discontinue the Utilities services. However, if such notice has not been received, the application of a succeeding occupant for Utilities services will automatically terminate the prior account. ~~A customer may pay a same day service fee to reconnect or disconnect services on the same day.~~ The customer's deposit may be transferred from one service location to another service location with City Utilities. The customer's deposit may be transferred from one name to another as long as the customer makes a request. ~~Rate for same day service fee shall be set as follows:~~

~~Same Day Service Fee \$70.46~~

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Section 200.04 METER INSTALLATION RATES.

(A) Each applicant shall be charged for the meter, backflow prevention device, meter service box and for installation of the meter. Rates for meter installations for all meter sizes will be set as follows:

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Section 200.05 METER TESTING.

(A) Meter testing shall be done at the customer's request, and in accordance with the following guidelines and schedules:

(1) *Meter Test Request.* If any customer requests a test of the meter, the City will require a meter test or bench test fee which fee shall be set as follows:

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Section 200.07 DISCONNECTING, RECONNECTING, AND TRANSFERRING SERVICE.

(A) There shall be a charge for City service connections and for transferring of City accounts from the name of one person to the name of another, which shall be paid before the service connection is made or accounts changed. There shall be no service connection charge if the original service connection for meter installation or service installation fee has been paid.

(1) *Transferring Service.* The charge for the transfer of service to a new customer account at a previously served location or reconnection of service subsequent to a customer requested disconnection shall be set as follows. If after the reconnection the customer does not have water service due to the main valve at the house being in the off position, and the field service representative returns to the property, an additional service initiation fee will be applied to the account for each return trip to be set as follows:

(2) *Reconnection.* When service is discontinued because of nonpayment of amounts due or non-sufficient funds, the disconnection/reconnection fee will be applied to the account as set forth below. If service is ordered discontinued because of nonpayment of the amount due, then payment is subsequently received (thus preventing the service from being discontinued), an administrative fee will be applied to the account. If service has been discontinued because of non-payment and water service is restored without authorization by the City, the City shall remove the meter and a pulled meter charge will be applied to the account. Service shall not be restored until the customer has paid the entire amount of the delinquent bill, together with penalties and the pulled meter charge. A re-install meter charge shall be applied to any account requesting to have a meter re-installed.

Note: Residential single family usage charge only applies to a maximum of 10,000 gallons per month.

(F) *Annual Index Adjustment.* The City hereby adopts automatic annual rate adjustments to apply to all water rates, miscellaneous fees and charges, except reclaimed water rates, wastewater rates, Capital Charges and Main Line Extension Charges, for utility services as necessary to provide for increases in expenses due to inflation or other such factors. This will ensure adequate net revenues to pay for inflationary increases in operations and maintenance of the system and to provide all utility-related debt service coverage requirements of the City. Unless a Certificate of the Consulting Engineer shall state differently, the adjustment shall be effective as of the first billing date on or after October 1 of each year and shall be equal to the then current index pursuant to the Florida Public Service Commission order establishing the price index for water and wastewater utilities, based on the Gross Domestic Product Implicit Price Deflator Index. The following increases shall apply to wastewater rates, after such time the automatic annual rate adjustments shall apply:

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Section 200.18 LEAKS AND WASTE.

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(C) *Causes for shutoff to be remedied; charge for turn-on.* Whenever the water supply to and for any premises has been shut off because of leaks or waste as in this section provided, the same shall not be turned on again until all cause or causes for shutoff shall have been remedied or removed, and until satisfactory assurance shall be given to the Utilities Department that the condition causing the shutoff will not again exist by the customer and a fee set as follows shall have been paid to the City.

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SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances not in conflict herewith are hereby continued in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Palm Bay that the

provisions of this Ordinance shall be made a part of the City of Palm Bay Code of Ordinances and the sections may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

SECTION 4. If any portion, clause, phrase, sentence or classification of this ordinance is held or declared to be either unconstitutional, invalid, inapplicable, inoperative or void, then such declaration shall not be construed to affect other portions of the ordinance; it is hereby declared to be the express opinion of the City Council of the City of Palm Bay that any such unconstitutional, invalid, inapplicable, inoperative or void portion or portions of this ordinance did not induce its passage, and that without the inclusion of any such portion or portions of this ordinance, the City Council would have enacted the valid constitutional portions thereof.


SECTION 5. The provisions within this ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 2013.


