CAMP RULES

1. Zero Tolerance on Bullying, Fighting, and Vulgar Language.
 2. Ask permission before leaving the group.
 3. Treat all equipment with respect and care.
 4. Walk **quietly** in the halls.
 5. Keep all hands and feet to yourself.
 6. Be respectful of other children and staff.
 7. Clean up after yourself following each activity.
 8. No toys or electronics are permitted.
 9. Dress appropriately; tennis shoes and play clothes are required daily.
- Please bring **breakfast, lunch, afternoon snack** and a **refillable water** bottle each day.
 - Breakfast and lunch will not be provided.
 - **NO** flip flops, Crocs, open-toe shoes, Heelys or sandals.
 - We are not responsible for lost and/or missing items.
 - Apply sunscreen before arriving at camp.
 - Campers may bring sunscreen to apply throughout the day.
 - Hats & sunglasses are permitted.
 - Pick up our weekly newsletter.
 - All trips and fees subject to change due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances.
 - To be eligible for a local trip (M,T, R, F), campers must attend at least two days of camp that week. To be eligible for a Wednesday trip, campers must attend at least three days of camp during that week.
 - On Wednesday field trips, campers **must** wear their camp t-shirts and arrive by the stated time. **NO EXCEPTIONS. We will not wait for late campers.**
 - Payment for entire week is due no later than Monday of that week (space permitting).
 - Payment for the field trip is due the Friday before the scheduled trip.
 - Field trip space is limited.
 - 50 campers on Wednesday, 33 on Mon/Tues/Thurs/Fri. (33 campers for the Wednesday, August 7 Andretti trip).
 - Trips and specials are optional; payment is required for participation.
 - Other than Wednesday trips, all other trips will be open for registration Friday at 7am prior to trip. (Registration for Andretti on August 7 will

CAMP DISCIPLINE POLICY

The following behaviors may lead to a disciplinary report, suspension or termination from the program:

1. Refusing to follow instructions and/or basic safety program rules.
2. Stealing or defacing City of Palm Bay property or the property of others. Campers are responsible for replacing equipment if deliberately misused or destroyed. The police will be notified of stealing or defacing property.
3. Bullying, fighting, kicking, hitting, biting or violence of any kind.
4. Being disrespectful towards staff, rude and/or inappropriate behavior towards others including but not limited to inappropriate language, cursing and/or rude gestures.
5. Throwing or kicking objects inside facilities unless done in an appropriately designated area such as the gymnasium.

Write-Ups:

Consequences that follows each write-up.

Fighting – Contact made or Vulgar Language

- 1st incident: all parties suspended 1 day
2nd incident: all parties suspended 1 week
3rd incident: all parties removed from program

Disrespectful, Horseplay or Vulgar Language

- 1st incident: problem solving; child calls parent
2nd incident: 1 day suspension
3th incident: 1 week suspension
4th incident: removal from program

Disrespectful OR Disruptive Behavior

- 1st incident: problem solving
2nd incident: child calls parent
3rd incident: 1 day suspension
4th incident: 1 week suspension
5th incident: removal from program
